



Sam the Safety Dog says ...

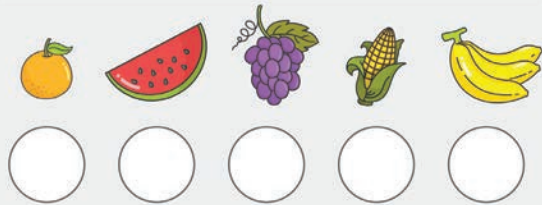
Sam, the NSC Safety Dog, is here to talk about safety with kids like you! This time, Sam has a special message about trick-or-treating:
